Masters Committee Suggestions

Both men's and women's older age events have had trouble reaching the necessary 8 team requirement. It is recommended that the following suggestions be implemented.

1 - Remove the 8 team requirement. (the USTA will hold a round robin tournament with less than 8 teams and still award the national gold, silver, and bronze balls.)

Quote from a tournament director -

"In addition, change the present rule that there has to be 8 players to qualify a draw for senior nationals. We have managed to pull it off 3 of the last 4 years but the players should not be penalized not to play a draw if they are available and only 6 teams can make it. It also poses a huge problem ordering favors and the cost of the event considering those decisions are made 3-4 weeks ahead on a draw that may not occur a week before the date it was planned on. I ate over \$1000 a few years ago due

to a cancelled event. Not so much worried about that but more about the fact that willing participants were not able to play."

- 2 Consider combining the 60 and up National Events with both A and B Championships. All participants would start in the same draw. First round winners continue to compete for the National A Championship and the First Round Losers would them compete for the National B Championship. To hold the National B Championship there would need to be a minimum of 8 teams signing up.
- 3 Schedule the oldest National Championships in the fall as many potential participants are in Florida or other southern climates in February and March.
- 4 Utilize the APTA Data Base to target all players who qualify for age group categories to try to increase participation.
- 5 When Sr National Events are held, do not require that more than 3 matches are played in one day. Finals should be played the next day.
- 6 The Committee is interested in trying to start a ranking system for men's 45 and 55 throughout all Regions.
