

Head Racquets Position.

Because of an unprecedented growth within our tennis and paddle tennis programs, the Elkridge Club is looking for a year-round Head Rackets Professional. The position starts April 1, but successful applicants may be eligible to start sooner.

The Head Professional will be responsible for teaching tennis/paddle/pickleball, private lessons, women's and men's team practices, adult and junior clinics including quick start, and junior camp. Other duties will include light court maintenance, shop hours and stringing. The Professional will direct or assist the Director with all programs, events, tournaments or special projects as assigned.

Although not essential, applicants with experience in paddle and pickle ball are preferred.

We are seeking individuals with a reputable work ethic, minimum 4.5 playing level, excellent people skills, and enthusiasm for the development of racquet sports. On-court interviews will be held in Baltimore.

The Compensation package for the Head Professional includes a salary, an on-court hourly rate for lessons and clinics, stringing, and meals during working hours. Health insurance is available on the first of the month after 60 days. A 401K plan is also available.
