POSITION DESCRIPTION:

The ideal candidate will work alongside the Director of Racquets to continue building upon the success of one of the most vibrant country club tennis programs in the tri-state area. This is a great opportunity to build a career as a future Director of Racquet Sports.

DUTIES (include but are not limited to):

Design, in conjunction with Director of Tennis, all women's and men's practices, junior programs, and run and organize adult tournament and events. The racquets professional will provide private and group lessons to juniors, ladies and men. Responsibilities include but are not limited to the following: help members with Tennis Shop sales, string rackets, communicate with the Director of Racquets regarding program status and strategies for growth, teach exclusively using 10 and under guidelines for juniors 4-10 years old, pro shop hours, administrative duties, respond to emails, book courts and lessons, and light court maintenance. Work with Director and fellow teaching professionals to form teams, make calls for player confirmation, send lineups and track weekly scores.

QUALIFICATIONS:

The ideal candidate will be a certified Tennis and Platform Tennis Professional, would have at least three years of experience teaching in a private club setting and have experience teaching women's competitive teams and 10 and under tennis. Must be able to relate to all ages and levels of junior players. Must possess strong communication skills and be a team player, be willing to work evenings and weekends, and have a very strong work ethic. College tennis experience and a minimum current playing level of 5.0 is required.

START DATE: April 1st. This is a YEAR-ROUND position: Tennis (April-September); mostly Paddle (October-March).

COMPENSATION:

The professional will also will be required to work six days a week during the tennis and five days a week during the paddle season.
