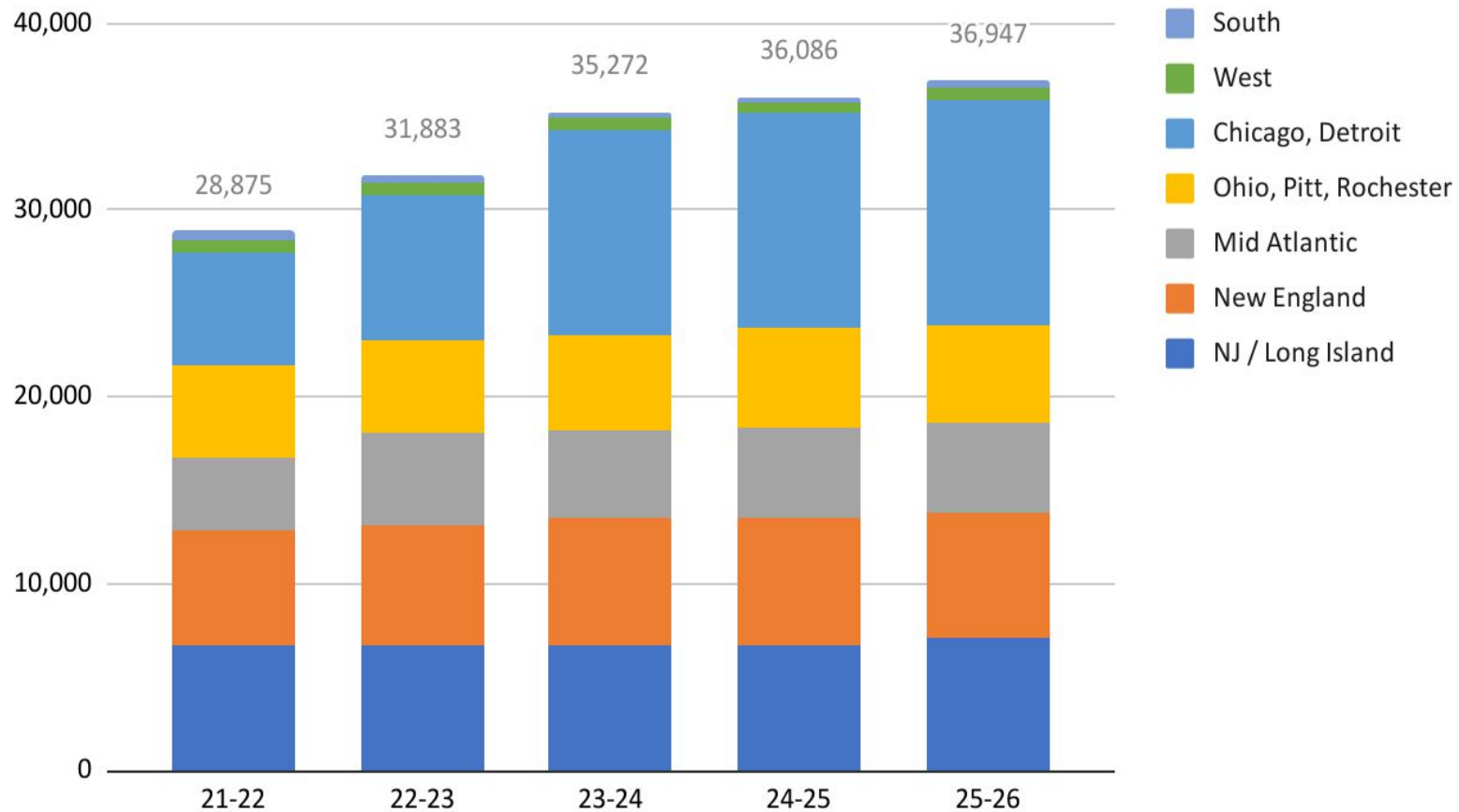

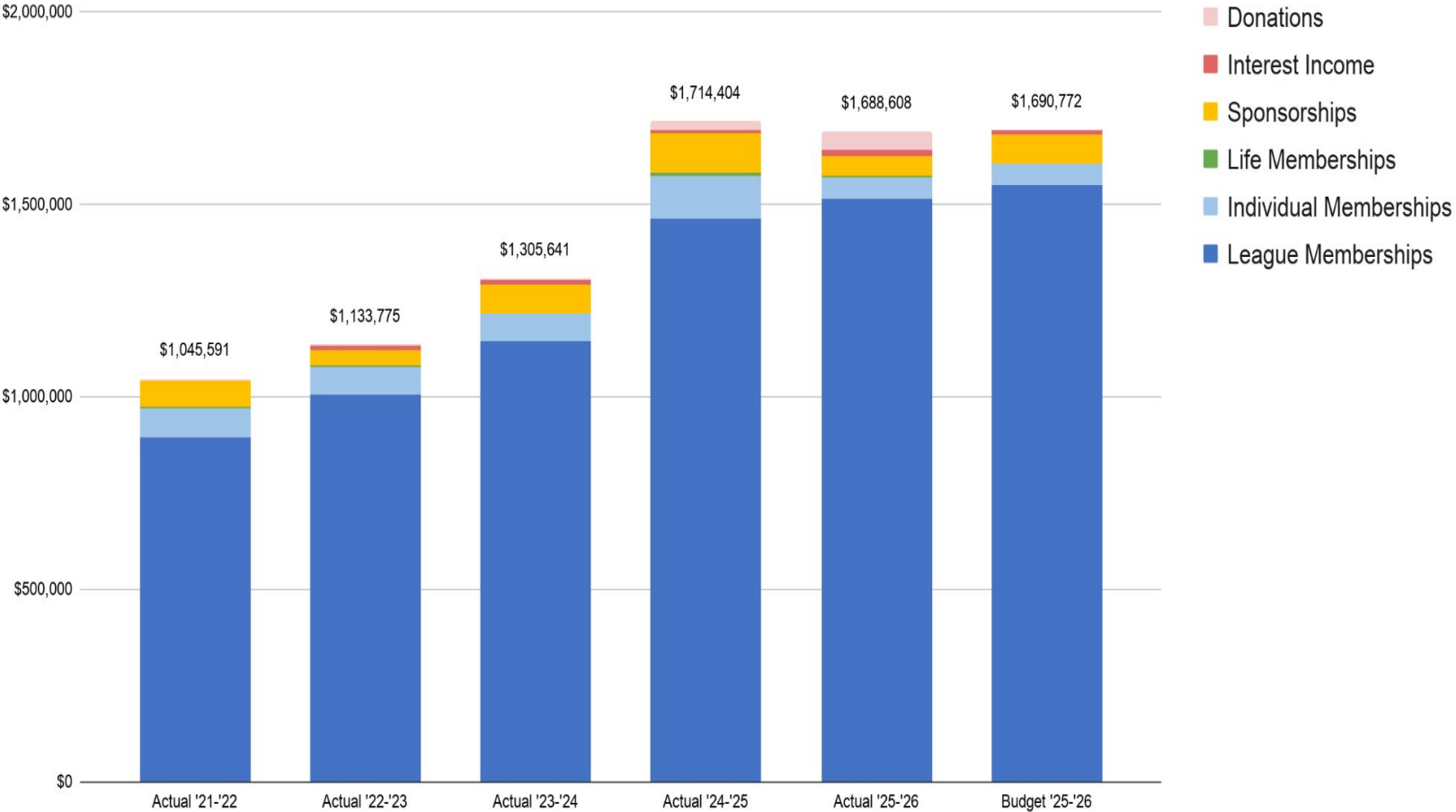

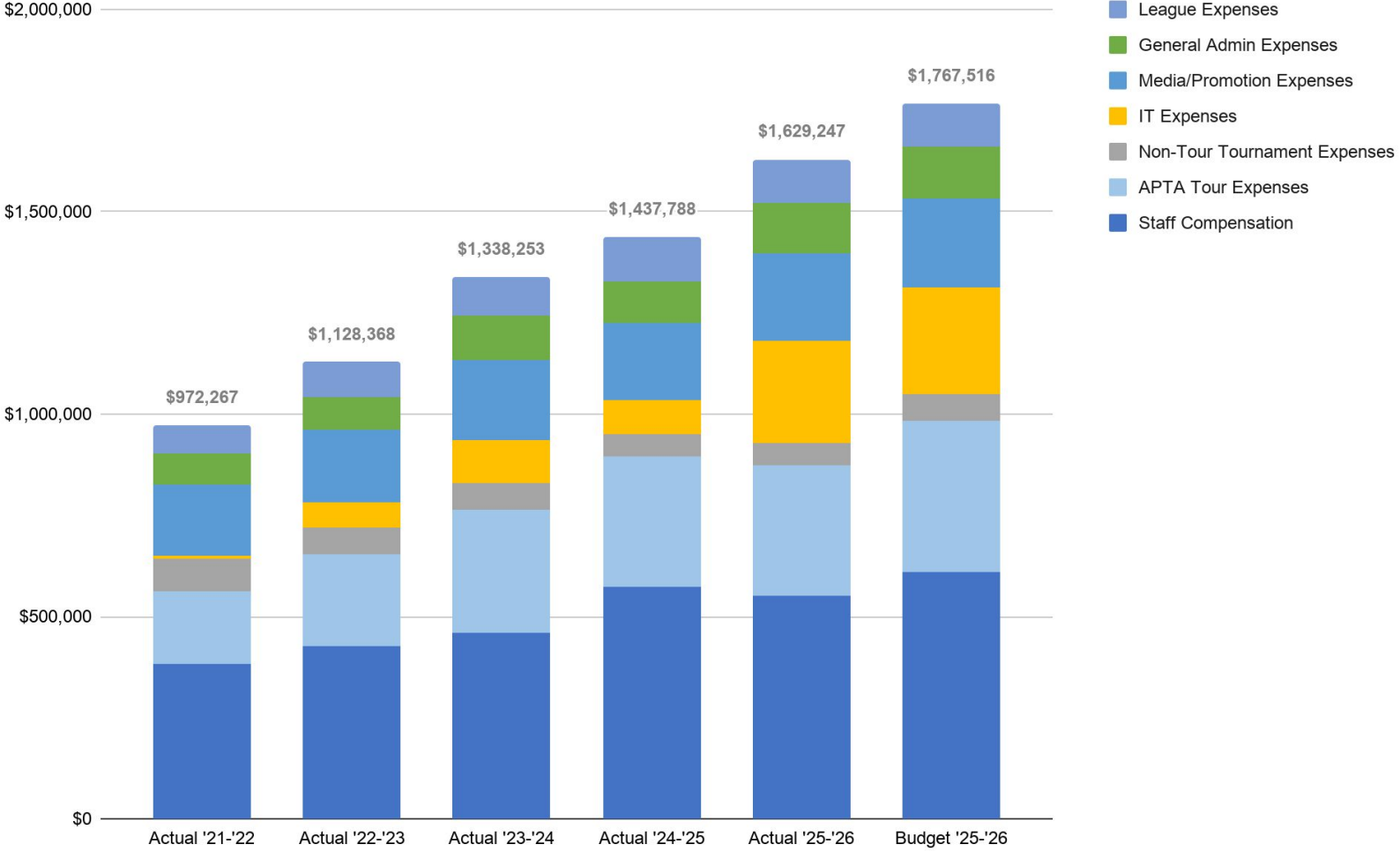
Memberships

Historical Revenues

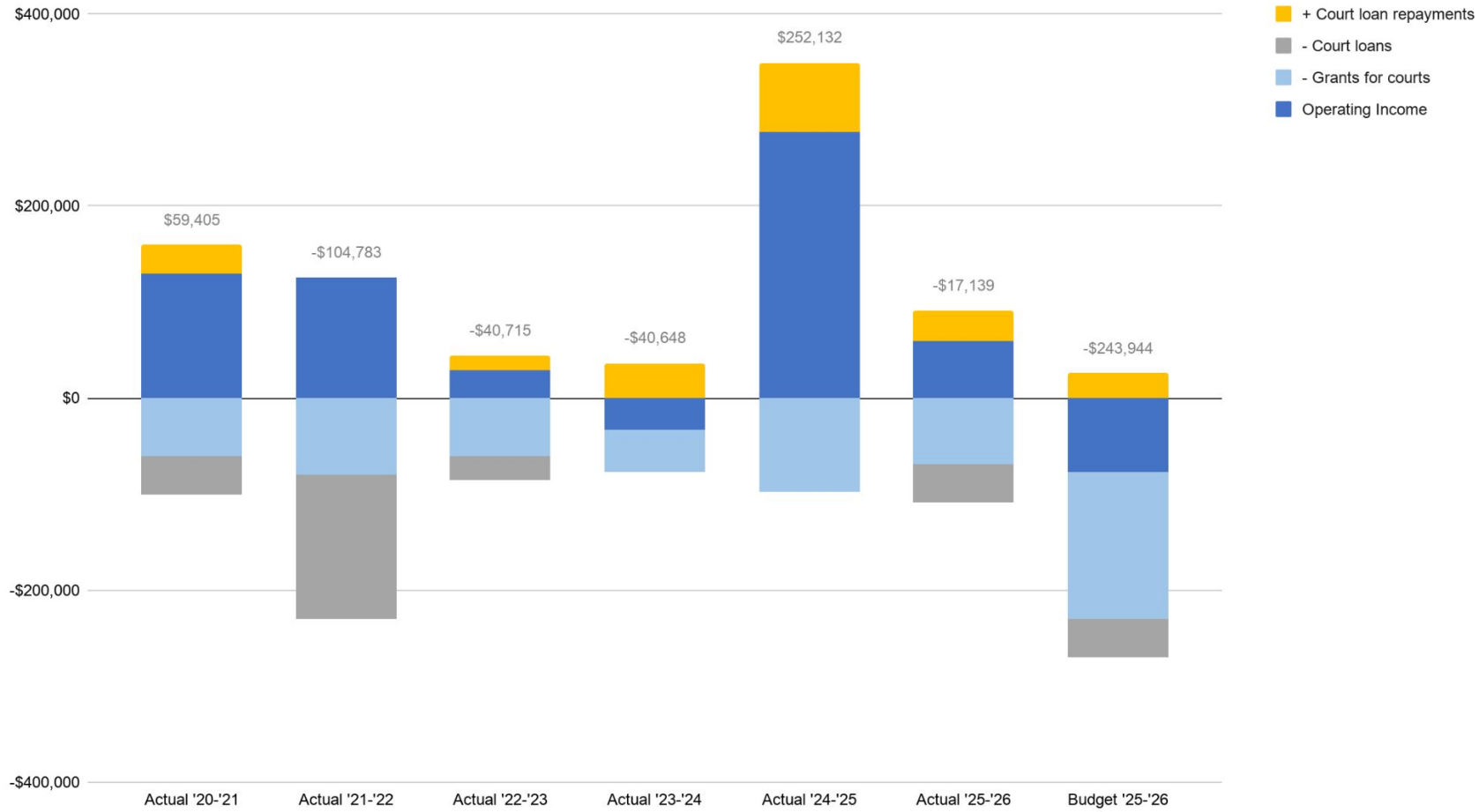
APTA Expenses



Historical Expenses

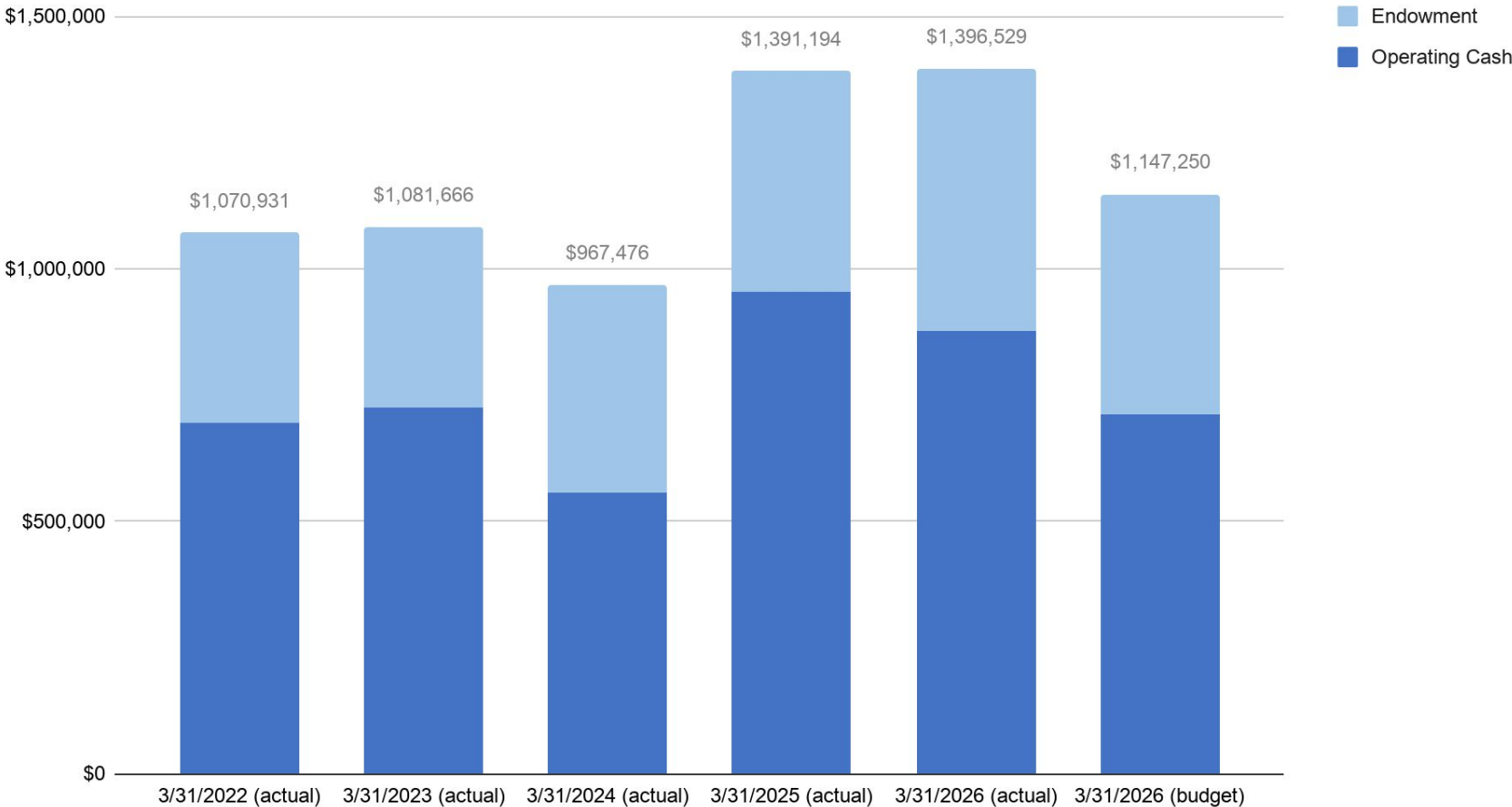


APTA Cash Flow

Grants and Loans

- The Grants and Loans committee provides financial assistance in all areas of the country to develop publicly accessible and affordable platform tennis facilities and courts.
- Nearly \$1.1 Million in award funding has been released since 2006.
- Over the last six years, \$675,000 has been awarded across 26 projects in support of the construction, relocation, and rehabilitation of 53 courts.
- The award mix comprises \$410,000 in grants and \$265,000 in loans. \$640,000 in funding for these awards has been released to date.
- This past year, \$20,000 was awarded across 1 project in support of the construction and rehabilitation of 4 courts and other facility enhancements.

2025-2026 season

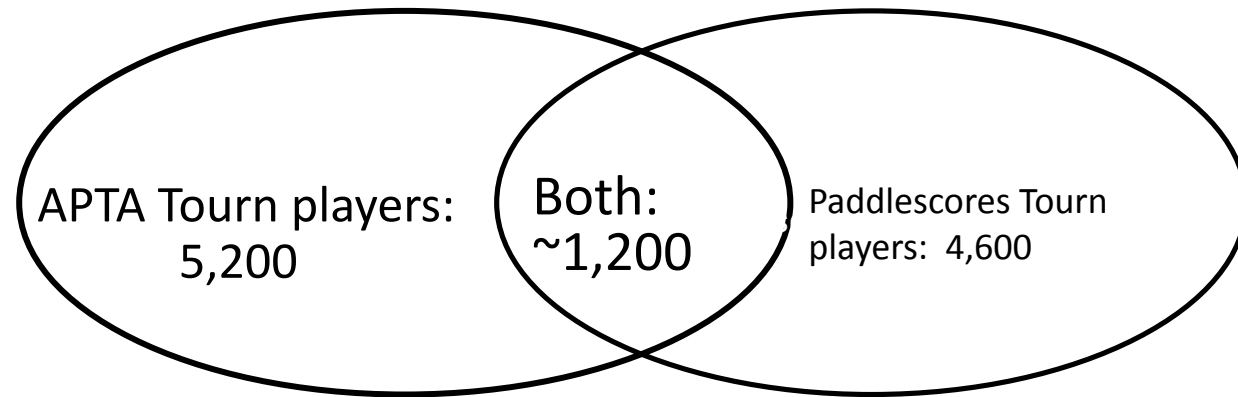
- 16 events (Nationals, 5 GPs and 10 Tour events)

- ~\$300k of prize money raised locally
- New venue: Delaware, Siwanoy
- Expanded streaming coverage

~ 8,500 APTA members (23% of membership) play tournaments



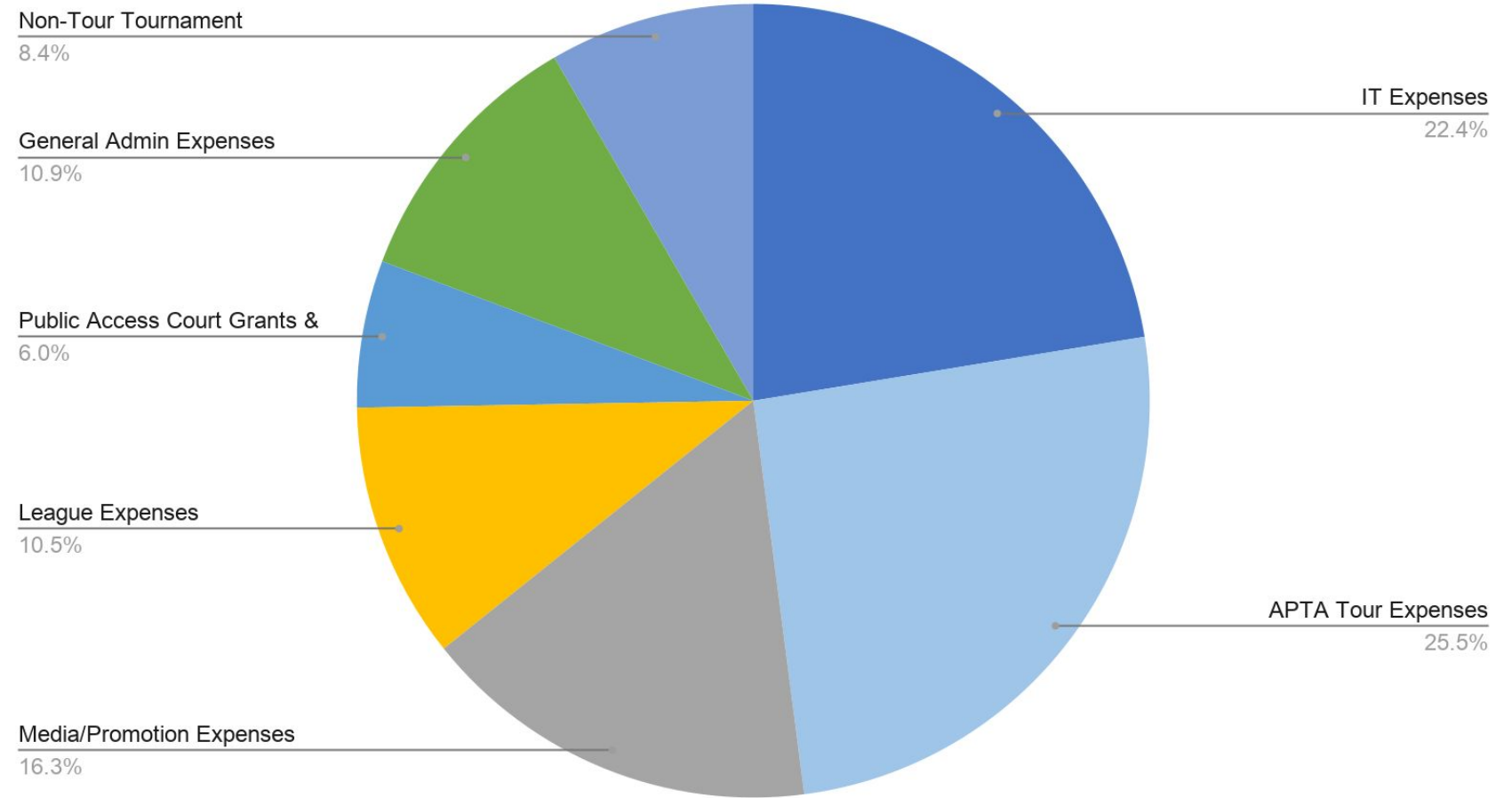
