- Assist with racquets events, tournaments, and member engagement initiatives
- Maintain a positive, professional, and welcoming environment for all members and guests
- Collaborate with the Director of Racquets on program development, scheduling, and any additional administrative work needed
- Ensure courts, equipment, and facilities are maintained to a high standard
- Tennis racket stringing
